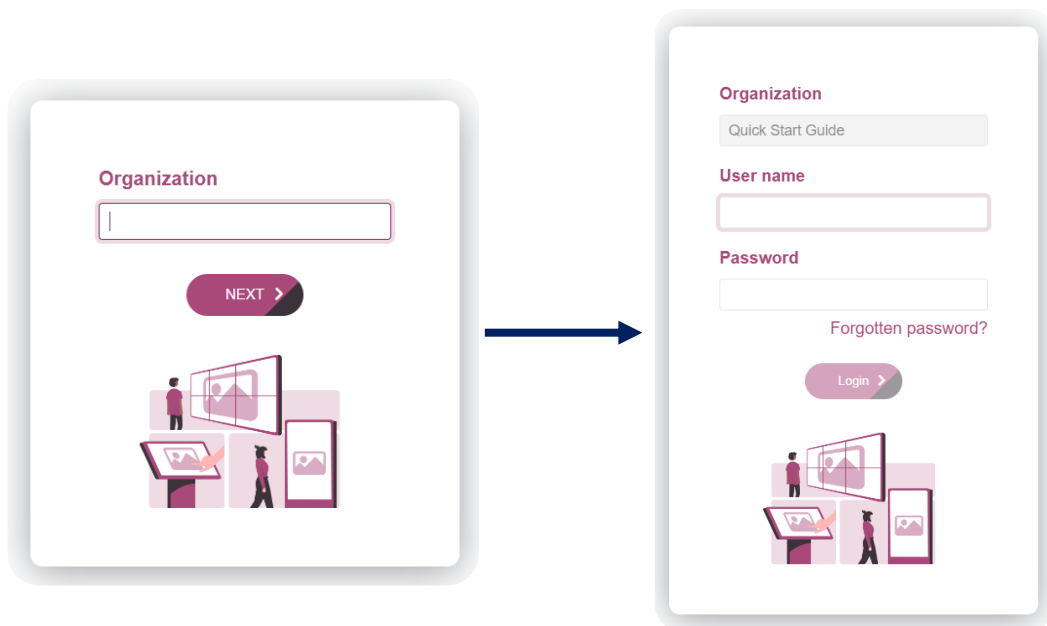

- Start the installation on the player (APK)
